

Registering/Paying On-line Instructions

To Register On-Line:

Go to bellville.cbsclass.org

Click on "Register Now" in upper right-hand corner.

Click on "Register" in the center of the page.

Enter your email.

They will send you an email to confirm your identity.

Open email.

Click on "Register."

Scroll to bottom of page under list of classes you've attended and click on "Register" by the year **2019-2020**.

Review information to ensure it's correct. If not, click on Edit information in right hand corner **BELOW** the "Register" Icon.

Correct Information if necessary.

If all correct, click on green "Register" Icon in upper right corner.

Answer Survey Question.

Click on green "Complete Registration" Icon.

You'll receive an email stating you've been enrolled. Once the Coordinator has accepted you into the class, you'll receive another email saying you've been ACCEPTED into the class. Now you may pay on-line.

To Pay On-Line:

In the email, click on the green "Pay for Your Registration Fees On-Line" Icon.

Click on:

"Add an optional donation" icon

Or

"Go to Payment Step" icon

Complete the Payment Details.

Click on "Enter Payment Information" Icon.

Complete Credit Card Information.

Click on "Everything Looks Right" Icon.

Click on "Complete Payment" Icon.

Download receipt and print for your records. Hang onto your receipt as proof of registration. (Just in case there are any hiccups in the new system).

Course Descriptions

Joshua: (6 weeks)

The book of Joshua picks up where Deuteronomy leaves off. After leading the Israelites out of Egypt and through 40 years of wanderings in the wilderness, Moses died. But God remained faithful to His promise. He appointed Joshua to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land, where they would at last find rest in a place of their own.

Revelation: (18 weeks)

An exciting study in which Jesus Christ appears in all His glory. He is revealed as the Lamb of God, Bridegroom, King, and Judge. Prophecies are examined against the backdrop of God's overriding plan for creation since the beginning of time and on through eternity. Class members will be inspired to worship and challenged to live in watchful readiness for the Lord's return.

James: (6 weeks)

The epistle James is one of the most practical books in the Bible. This course's lessons encourage each class member to lead a more consistent, caring Christian life and to explore the practical application of faith in family and society.
